NARRATIVE 1

Both PNS (Pensacola) and HZR (New Roads - False River) use the same VHF 121.25 for respective ASOS and ATIS broadcast.

The HZR ASOS signal is stronger and prevents reception of PNS ATIS. We have received complete information only after talking to Pensacola Approach Controller.

SYNOPSIS

Air carrier First Officer reported PNS and HZR airport ASOS and ATIS broadcast on the same frequency, with HZR being the stronger output.
