NARRATIVE 1	

Nighttime taxi going to the inner runway, so very quick taxi, and the transition from Taxiway Z to Taxiway K4 was poorly marked.

NARRATIVE 2

While taxiing out from Dubai International to the runway there was some confusion as to [Taxiway] Z versus [Taxiway] Z11 to get to Taxiway K4. The lines were not well marked and in the dark it was difficult to see and Taxiway Z on the 10-9 doesn't get you to the runway. Ground called and told us no problem that we missed the proper taxiway.

SYNOPSIS

Air carrier flight crew reported the lines on a taxiway transition at OMDB were poorly marked and difficult to see, especially during nighttime.
