NARRATIVE 1	

I have flew into SJC four times during my last rotation. I noticed that the taxi signs are very difficult to identify due to high grass covering the markings. I notified ATC twice and they honestly did not seem to care. I flew into SJC today a week later and no corrective action has been taken. It is actually worse now. I called ATC Clearance after we parked to notify them. They did not seem very interested in the issue. This is a hazard to taxiing aircraft.

SYNOPSIS

Fractional jet Captain reported taxi signage at SJC was covered by tall grass and was difficult to see. The pilot notified ATC but upon returning to the airport a week later, noticed that no corrective action had been taken.
