NARRATIVE 1	

Departing from the FBO ramp, the taxi instructions were runway 31R via taxiway A hold short of taxiway A1. Upon review of the 10-9 chart prior to taxiing, I noticed that taxiway A2 on the Jepp chart is designated as taxiway A1 on Safetaxi. Likewise, taxiway A3 on the Jepp chart is designated taxiway A2 on Safetaxi. There may be additional taxiways inaccurately designated, but I can only verify the two.

The active Safetaxi database is 24S5 dated 9/5/24. The most recent Jepp 10-9 chart is dated 10/25/24, Eff 10/31/24. It may be that the Safetaxi database is lagging behind any Jepp chart changes, or the taxiway designations are simply inaccurate.

I spoke to the chief pilot regarding the above and for now, I am keeping a watchful eye for any other discrepancies with Safetaxi.

SYNOPSIS

First Officer reported a discrepancy between the DAL Jeppesen taxi chart and the taxiways displayed on the Safetaxi chart.
