NARRATIVE 1	

During preflight the NOTAMs were reviewed with no information regarding Runway 11 threshold markings. After receiving takeoff clearance at GJT for Runway 11, we verified the runway and turned onto the runway at the end which is A2 and aligned to the centerline. While adding takeoff power, the Runway Awareness and Advisory System (RAAS) stated, "Approaching Runway 11," then, "Caution, on taxiway, on taxiway." We visually verified the runway again and confirmed our position, I commanded to continue, and we had a normal uneventful takeoff on Runway 11. The 10-9 is not clear about a displaced threshold and there is nothing on the 10-7 or NOTAMs. There are no white arrows or yellow chevrons at A2 for runway markings. In the debrief, a recent photo of the runway shows a change at A2.

SYNOPSIS

Air carrier Captain reported that while departing GJT Runway 11 the flight crew received a warning from the RAAS possibly related to an unmarked displaced threshold.
