NARRATIVE 1	

We landed on Runway 22 and exited on the closed Runway 31L. We contacted Ground who cleared us to FBO via L, C, P. Looking at the chart I saw L and C but no P on the other side of 31R. However, I did see P from L via M. We stopped short of 31R on P while my FO was trying to get clarification of how to proceed from P and to confirm we were cleared to cross the closed Runway 31R. At this point the controller informed us we were cleared to cross 31R on L then C and P to FBO.

There is no label on the chart to indicate P is the taxiway to FBO, thus led to the confusion.

Suggestions: To help prevent this from happening, the chart should be revised to label the taxiway to FBO as a continuation of Taxiway P on the east side of Runway 31R crossing Taxiway C.

SYNOPSIS

Fractional Captain reported the flight crew was confused trying to find Taxiway P at HOU Airport and noted that there was no label on the chart to indicate P is the taxiway to the FBO.
