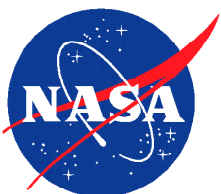

NARRATIVE 1

I have flown the RYYMN3 Arrival 4 times in the last week, and despite the NOTAM "BNA STAR NASHVILLE INTL, NASHVILLE, TN. RYYMN THREE (RNAV) ARRIVAL... TURNT TRANSITION NOT AVBL OR AUTH," Center and Approach has requested us to fly the TURNT transition each time and with different expectations each time: fly the transition without speed or altitude constraints, fly the transition with altitude constraint only, and fly the transition with constraints. We requested clarification each time and was given different instructions.

SYNOPSIS

Air carrier Captain reported ATC provides different instructions each time for the RYYMN3 Arrival to BNA that conflict with instructions listed in the NOTAM.
