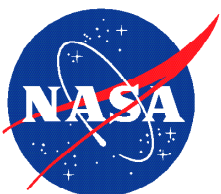

TJBQ/BQN airfield altitude as listed on the 10-9 Airport Info page (revised Day 4) lists airport elevation as 238 feet. ACARS takeoff data as of Day 0 was still using an AFE of 237 feet. Airport elevation on various other Jepp charts with revision dates prior to Day 4 list airport elevation as 237 feet.

SYNOPSIS

Air carrier Captain reported that the field elevation listed for TJBQ Airport is different between ACARS takeoff data and various other Jeppesen charts.
